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# Ring bearer, ITH project

## Step-by-step instructions

### What you need for this project:

- satin fabric 2 pieces 13" x 9"
- 5" x 7" hoop
- 2" wide lace, about 10" long
- 0.5" wide ribbon, same colour as the lace
- sewing needle and thread for closing the gap after stuffing the cushion
- Tear-away stabilizer
- Temporary glue-on spray if floating fabric

### Step 1

#### Prepare your tools and materials:



*Cut 8" of lace and 12" of ribbon, tie the lace at the middle with the ribbon, make a bow from it. Hoop your fabric or float it on one layer of tear-away stabilizer. If you float, apply the temporary spray to the stabilizer, stick on the fabric and secure in place with 4 pins at the corners*

**Step 2** *Embroider the first colour (5 small placement stitches for the ribbon).*

**Step 3** *Change the thread to the next colour, this will do the placement stitches for the butterfly applique.*

**Step 4** *Change thread and place the remaining 2" of lace over the butterfly placement stitches, embroider the butterfly contour, cut off the excess fabric.*

**Step 5** *Change thread embroider the rest of the butterfly and the text.*

**Step 6** *Replace thread, embroider the placement line for the back of the cushion.*

**Step 7** *With the placement line in place, now the lace with the ribbon should be placed where the 5 short stitches are, the middle of the lace (where the ribbon bow is) goes to the middle of the embroidery. The two ends of the lace go to the corners, between the 2 short placement stitches. Pin them down carefully, not to have the pins in the way of the needle when embroidering next step.*



**Step 8** *Place the hoop back and embroider the next colour which will sew the lace to the project.*

**Step 9** *Change thread, put the fabric layer for the back side of the cushion right side down, flatten it as much as possible without loosening the embroidery in the hoop. It will not lay flat because of the ribbon and lace underneath but that's perfectly okay. Run the stitches which sew together front and back of the cushion, with a gap at the bottom.*



### **Step 10**

*Change thread, now it will embroider the margins with zigzag stitches. Now the embroidery phase is done!*

### **Step 11**

*Remove the piece from the hoop, cut it close to the zigzag stitch carefully not to cut the thread. Turn the cushion right side out.*



**Step 12** *Fill the cushion with stuffing, loosely but full enough to have the corners filled properly.*



**Step 13** *Stitch the opening manually, then stitch the middle of the bow and lace from the right side to the back side and pull the thread all the way to make a hollow in the middle of the cushion for the rings to sit in when they get tied with a bow. And yuppeee, your beautiful cushion is ready! One more step, just not to finish at step 13:*

**Step 14**

*Wrap the cushion with love and give it as a present to the ones who are just a "yes" away from happiness!*

*Happy stitching!*
