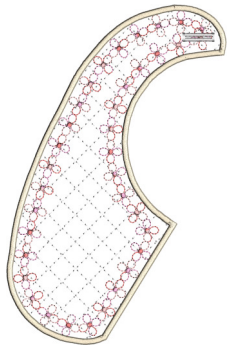

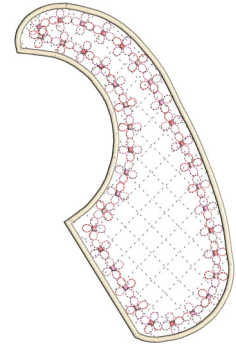



# **TUTORIAL**

## **BIBS FOR SMALL HOOP 5X7 IN 3 PIECES**

These baby bibs are done in applique in 3 pieces, a centre piece and 2 side pieces, then sewn together with your sewing machine. They have a batting inlay to keep baby dry and a towel backing which gives the bib that perfect finish. The completed bib measures approximately 213X235mm and will fit babies from 6-18 months old. The hooping instructions are the same for all 3 pieces.

- 1) Use a 130x180mm Hoop size for all 3 pieces.
- 2) Hoop 2 layers of water soluble fabric in hoop and pull tight.
- 3) Cut a piece of compressed batting the size of the inside of hoop and place it inside of hoop, use spray or pins to keep it from shifting, making sure pins are not in the line of sewing.
- 4) Cut a piece of fabric for the bib a little bigger than the hoop and place that on top of batting use spray or pins to prevent the fabric from moving. Place hoop onto machine.
- 5) Sew the first 3 colours normally Navy Blue, Red and White the white colour being the cross hatch fill quilting stitch.
- 6) Remove hoop from the machine and trim fabric only around the outside line of sewing being careful not to cut too close to line of sewing.
- 7) Each bib is different some have 2 or more applique placements and the same applies for each applique placement, sew the straight stitch line then place the fabric on top according to the shape sewn, then sew straight and zig zag stitch line, then cut around the fabric, replace hoop on machine and finish off with a satin stitch.

8) Continue sewing until you get to last 3 or 2 colours which is normally green, off white and white colours. The Green is a outline stitch for placing towelling to the back of bib, the off white colour is the final outline satin stitch that sews all around the piece and the white colour is for the button hole which is only sewn on the left hand side. The right side does not have a button hole.

9) Remove the hoop from machine before you start with colour green, cut a piece of towelling fabric a bit bigger than the hoop and place it at the back of hoop, make sure it is nice and flat without pleats or crinkles, pin it down to back of hoop or use spray sew the straight stitch all around the edge of bib.

10) Remove hoop and cut all around the sewn edge of towelling at the back of hoop. Also cut the batting around the edge inside the hoop but do not cut the water soluble fabric.

11) Continue with satin stitch sewn all around the edge of the motive and the buttonhole for the left side of bib.

12) Repeat this procedure for all three pieces. When complete join all 3 pieces together with your sewing machine using a small satin stitch the same colour as the outside satin stitch.

13) I have digitized these bibs for the ladies with machines that use small hoops enabling you to also make bibs for your babies. Hope you enjoy making them as much as I have enjoyed creating them have fun.

NB. Be careful not to apply to much pressure on the water soluble fabric as this will cause stretching and then your bibs will not sew out perfectly.
