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The billfold wallet

The size of the wallet in the finished form 100x230 mm (3.95x9.07")

The size of the wallet folded 100x115 mm (3.95x4.54")

Pay attention

When the wallet is folded the inner piece is curved a little. With this processing method we can't avoid the curve since all the pieces are of the same size. It is impossible to make the inner piece smaller as in traditional sewing. The appearance is not spoiled in this case and the functionality is not affected but I just want to warn about this small particularity.

Necessary materials.


The choice of fabric depends on your preferences.





I use eco-leather and vinyl leather with a thickness of 0.6-0.85 mm. If the skin is very thin, it should be glued with a thin dublerin. You can also use cotton linen, satin. The filler – rubber foam with a thickness of 5 mm or polyester batting 80 or 100.

Cut the fabric, lining and batting the size and quantity according to the table.

Download the archive to your computer. Extract the files from the archive. Download files 1 and 2 to your embroidery machine in the way you are used to.

	<p>Stage 1. Embroidery of the inside of the wallet.</p> <p>Fold pieces of the lining B and D half widthways (wrong sides together) and iron the fold.</p>
	<p>Select file 1. Hoop tearaway or cutaway stabilizer of medium density. Stitch Color 1 - the placement line for lining.</p>



Remove the hoop and turn it over so the wrong side is up.

Place Lining (A) .
You can use temporary fixation spray.


Stitch Color 2 - the placement line for design and fixing the lining




(back of hoop view)



Put the main fabric face up.




Stitch Color 3 - zigzag for trimming and fixing the fabric.



Cut the fabric inside the zigzag stitch.



Turn the hoop it over so the wrong side is up.
Cut the lining inside the zigzag stitch.





Stitch Color 4 - satin border



Remove the hoop from the machine and turn
to the back side.
(back of hoop view)



Take the piece lining ironed in half (**B**), put it
with the folded part to the stitch, then unfold
it so that the piece is in a single layer. The
ironed fold should coincide with the stitch. Fix it
with an adhesive tape.



Stitch Color 5 - zigzag for trimming and fixing the fabric.

Cut the fabric inside the zigzag stitch.


Turn the hoop it over so the wrong side is up.



Cut the lining inside the zigzag stitch.



Stitch Color 6 - satin border



(back of hoop view)






Unfold the fabric in the place of the fold made earlier.
Fix it with an adhesive tape.




Put 1 more piece of lining (C).
Fix it with an adhesive tape.



Stitch Color 7 - zigzag for trimming
and fixing the lining.






Cut off the exceed material around near zigzag stitch, on both sides of the hoop.

!! Do not cut near straight lines !!

Stitch Color 8 - satin border



Remove the hoop from the machine and turn to the back side.



Take the piece lining ironed in half (**D**), put it with the folded part to the borderstitch.

Use this piece if you want to have two pockets for banknotes.




Fix it with an adhesive tape.



Stitch Color 9 - fixing the pocket.





The inner part for the wallet is ready.



Embroidery the outer details and put together the purse.



Select file 2.
Hoop tearaway or cutaway stabilizer of medium density.
Stitch Color 1 - the placement line for lining.



Remove the hoop from the machine and turn to the back side.
Place Lining (C).
You can use temporary fixation spray.




Put polyester batting.
You can use temporary fixation spray.



Stitch Color 2



Cut the polyester batting around the stitching. I recommend cutting the polyester batting at this stage to avoid thick seams.



Put the main fabric face up.




Stitch Color 3 - the main design.



Remove the hoop from the machine and turn to the back side.

(back of hoop view)



Put the embroidered inner part for the wallet face up to the line embroidered earlier
Put together the outer contour lines.



Stitch Color 4 - zigzag for trimming



(back of hoop view)



Cut off the exceed material around near zigzag stitch, on both sides of the hoop.




(back of hoop view)



Stitch Color 5 - satin border



Cut stabilizer. Remove the stabilizer residues with a wet sponge



Mark the snap button location
Put the button.




Billfold is ready
