Wallet with 3 departments (euro)

Comfortable, beautiful, small wallet with 3 departments.

The wallet is made in 3 stages of embroidery and 2 hand stitches. Sewing machine is not needed.

Pay attention this is a universal instruction.

This instruction will work with most of these purses. So the patterns in the photo may be different (I'm sorry). But Photos with this purchased design will be placed next.

Recommended fabrics.

The choice of fabric depends on your preferences.

I use eco-leather and vinyl leather with a thickness of 0.6-0.85 mm. If the skin is very thin, it should be glued with a thin dublerin. You can also use cotton linen, satin.

The filler – rubber foam with a thickness of 5 mm or polyester batting 80 or 100.



Download the archive to your computer. Extract the files from the archive. Download files 1, 2, 3 to your embroidery machine in the way you are used to.

File 1 - Side panel parts



Select file 1.
Hoop tearaway or water-soluble stabilizer.



Stitch Color 1 - the placement line for design




Remove the hoop from the machine.
Place Lining larger piece on the hoop right side up.
Fix it with glue or adhesive tape.



Turn to the back side.
Place Lining on the hoop right side up.
Fix it with glue or adhesive tape.



Stitch Color 2



Cut off the exceed material around the semicircular lines near zigzag stitch, on both sides of the hoop. But do not cut off the fabric along the straight stitches!




Stitch Color 3



Remove the remaining stabilizer.
The first two pieces are ready.

File 2 - The detail of the partition




Select file 2.
Hoop tearaway or water-soluble stabilizer.



Stitch Color 1 - the placement line for design



Remove the hoop from the machine.
Place Lining larger piece on the hoop right side up.
Fix it with glue or adhesive tape.





Turn to the back side.
Place Lining on the hoop right side up.
Fix it with glue or adhesive tape.



Stitch Color 2
This will fix the lining and
These are auxiliary stitches that will serve you in the
future



Put the side panel parts to the side lines, As on photo.
Be careful.
Make sure you combine the correct lines. See picture.



Small part



Secure the pieces with adhesive tape. Make sure that the adhesive tape does not fall under the stitch and under the fastening of the hoop.





Stitch Color 3 - zigzag for trimming



Cut off the exceed fabric close to the stitch on both sides of the hoop.





Stitch Color 4 - satin border.
Remove the stabilizer.



Partition detail with side panels is ready.

File 3 - The main part of the wallet



Select file 3.

Hoop tearaway or water-soluble stabilizer

(I decided to save a little stabilizer.

And used the leftovers. It is very convenient on such products.) 😊

Stitch Color 1 - the placement line for design



Remove the hoop from the machine and turn to the back side.

Place the interfacing fabric face up on the back of the hoop.

Fix it with glue or adhesive tape.



Stitch Color 2

These are auxiliary stitches that will serve you in the future.



Put polyester batting.

You can use temporary fixation glue.



Stitch Color 3



Cut off the excess polyester batting around near stitch.
I recommend cutting the polyester batting at this stage to avoid thick seams.



Put the main fabric face up.


Fix it with glue or adhesive tape.

Please note that in this model there is no any stitch that fixes the fabric to the stabilizer, since numerous tests of various fabrics have shown that some fabrics may move slightly while embroidering and therefore a fold can appear at the edge of the embroidery.



Stitch Color 4-6

I used thread 1 color






Take the partition detail.
Fold the side panels along the fold line, as foto.



Turn detail



Remove the hoop from the machine and turn to the back side.



Put the partition detail to the central and side lines, so that the lines match with the stitches, embroidered early. As on photo.



Secure the pieces with adhesive tape. Make sure that the adhesive tape does not fall under the stitch and under the fastening of the hoop.



Stitch Color 7 - zigzag for trimming



Cut off the exceed fabric close to the stitch on both sides of the hoop.





Stitch Color 8 - satin border.
Remove the stabilizer

The main part of the wallet are ready.

Put together the wallet



Fold your wallet.

Combine together sides of the partition details




Make a hand stitch.
I recommend using durable double thread.
Hide the knot between the pieces, make 6-7 stitches passing through the top edge. then sew with hand stitches, which you like best.

You can use a sewing machine.

Do it from two sides.



Put or sew the button.



The wallet are ready.
