The cosmetic bag (7x11, 8x12)

Necessary materials.

The choice of fabric depends on your preferences.

I use eco-leather and vinyl leather with a thickness of 0.6-0.85 mm. If the skin is very thin, it should be glued with a thin dublerin. You can also use cotton linen, satin. The filler – rubber foam with a thickness of 5 mm or polyester batting 80 or 100.

2 Zipper with a small slider-

1 -the size is a little more than the width of the cosmetic bag.

1 - the size 8 inches

Cut the fabric, lining and batting the size and quantity according to the table.



Stage 1.
Embroidery of the back side of the cosmetic bag (if necessary)




Hoop tearaway or cutaway stabilizer of medium density.

Stitch Color 1



Put the zipper (the size 8 inches) on the stitching. Make sure that the middle of the zipper coincides with the stitching.



Fix the zipper with paper adhesive tape or with the temporary fixation spray.

Stitch Color 2 Fixing the zipper




Put the cut of the main fabric **A** on the bottom stitching, wrong side up, covering the zipper. You can reduce the speed of the machine and control the embroidery.




Stitch Color 3




Turn the fabric face up covering the polyester batting.



Stitch Color 4 - fixing the fabric to the stabilizer




Turn the hoop over.




Put the cut of the lining **C** on the stitching (on which the main fabric was previously sewn) wrong side up, covering the zipper.


Fix the fabric with adhesive tape. Make sure that the fabric does not obstruct the fastening of the hoop.



Stitch Color 5




Turn the lining face up. Fix it with glue or adhesive tape.






Put the cut of the main fabric **B** on the top stitching, wrong side up, covering the zipper. You can reduce the speed of the machine and control the embroidery.



Stitch Color 6



Turn the fabric face up
Fix it with glue or adhesive tape.

Turn the hoop upside down. Open the zipper
half way (It is important)

I recommend using paper tape on the edge of
the zipper so that the sewing foot does not
touch the zipper.




Turn the hoop to the back side.

Put the lining **D** face down. Fix it with adhesive tape. Do NOT use spray at this stage.



Stitch Color 7 - The upper part of the fabric and the lining will be fixed.


Remove all metal parts on the zipper, if any.



Put the cut of the main fabric **B** on the stitching, wrong side up on both sides as in the photo

Secure with adhesive tape

You can reduce the speed of the machine and control the embroidery.



Stitch Color 8



Turn the fabric face up
Fix it with glue or adhesive tape.



Stitch Color 9

Remove the remaining stabilizer.

The back of the bag is ready.

If you do not need embroidery on the back, skip step 1.

	<p>Stage 2. Embroidery of the Details of the partition (if necessary)</p>
	<p>Take the lining, according to table F G H Fold each piece in half and iron it.</p>
	<p>Select file 2 Hoop tearaway stabilizer. Stitch Color 1 - the placement line for design.</p>
	<p>Place the folded edges Lining F in line with arrow</p>
	<p>Stitch Color 2</p>



Attach the folded side of the piece **G** to the stitch as in the photo.
Fix the pieces with an adhesive tape.



Stitch Color 3



Place the second piece **G** slightly lower than the first one. (about an inch). Fix the pieces with an adhesive tape.




Stitch Color 4



Place the third piece **G** slightly lower than the first one. (about an inch). Fix the pieces with an adhesive tape.




Stitch Color 5



If you want a pocket on the other side

Turn the hoop over so the wrong side is up.

Place the piece **H** slightly lower than the stitch.
(about an inch). Fix the pieces with an adhesive
tape.



Stitch Color 6



Remove the remaining stabilizer.

Inside piece are ready.



If you don't need an internal partition, skip this step.


Stage 3
Embroidery of the front and sewing the cosmetic bag.



Hoop tearaway or cutaway stabilizer of medium density.
Stitch Color 1




Put the zipper on the stitching. Make sure that the middle of the zipper coincides with the stitching.



Fix the zipper with paper adhesive tape or with the temporary fixation spray.

Stitch Color 2




Put the cut of the main fabric **O** on the bottom stitching, wrong side up, covering the zipper. You can reduce the speed of the machine and control the embroidery.




Stitch Color 3



Put a piece of polyester batting **O** (or another material for creating volume).



Stitch Color 4





Cut the polyester batting around the stitching. Be very careful not to cut the fabric.



Turn the fabric face up covering the polyester batting.



Stitch Color 5-6 - the main design.



Turn the hoop over.

Put the cut of the lining **O** on the stitching (on which the main fabric was previously sewn) wrong side up, covering the zipper.

Fix the fabric with adhesive tape. Make sure that the fabric does not obstruct the fastening of the hoop.



Stitch Color 7



Turn the lining face up. Fix it with glue or adhesive tape.





Turn the hoop upside down. Open the zipper half way (It is important)



To make the 2 loops for the rings (if you need them)



Open the zipper half way (It is important)
Put loops.
Make sure that the metal parts do not fall under the seam.

Stitch Color 8- loop fixation.


If you do not need loops - do not embroider this color.



Put the embroidered back face down.
Put together the outer contour lines.


Fix it with adhesive tape.

If you haven't embroidered the back, put the main fabric face down and the polyester batting on the top. If the fabric is thick, you can do without polyester batting.




Stitch Color 9

Tip: reduce the speed of the machine, control the top part and correct it if necessary. The stitching should fall into the outer contour line.



Remove the hoop from the machine and turn to the back side.



Put the details of the partitio.
Put together the outer contour lines.
Fix it with adhesive tape.



Stitch Color 10



Put the lining **O** face down. Fix it with adhesive tape. Do NOT use spray at this stage.



Stitch Color 11



Cut the lining at the distance of 0.5 inches from the stitching. The allowance from the side of the opening should be wider.

Cut the corners as in the photo.



Turn the cosmetic bag out through the opening in the side seam.



Sew the opening with hand stitches.



Or fix it with adhesive interfacing with the help of an iron.



Remove the remaining stabilizer near the zipper.
Turn the cosmetic bag out through the open zipper.
Straighten the corners.



The cosmetic bag is ready
