# How to make a raw edge applique



THE FIRST THING TO STITCH OUT IS A DIELINE FOR THE APPLIQUE PIECE.



IF YOU WANT YOU CAN LIGHTLY SPRAY THE BACK OF THE APPLIQUE FABRIC, WITH TEMPORARY SPRAY ADHESIVE. OR SIMPLY PLACE THE PIECE OVER THE STITCHED FIGURE. YOUR MACHINE WILL CONTINUE TO EMBROIDER OVER THE PIECE.



YOUR FINISHED EMBROIDERY SHOULD LOOK LIKE THIS.



REMOVE THE FABRIC FROM YOUR HOOP AND CUT THE VINYL EVENLY AROUND THE EDGE OF YOUR EMBROIDERY. YOU CAN USE THE STITCHES TO GUIDE YOUR SCISSORS. ALSO YOU CAN FOLD THE FABRIC TO EASILY CUT IT AROUND THE EMBROIDERY.
