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Luggage Handle Wrap In The Hoop Instructions:

Blank Version



1. Hoop your stabilizer. You can use water soluble stabilizer or tearaway stabilizer. (If you like, you can use a little bit of adhesive to keep the fabric in place).
2. Stitch the first step of the design, which is a placement step that will show you where to put your fabric. Using a fabric that won't fray, such as vinyl, place the fabric on top of the placement stitches.
3. Stitch step 2, which will tack down the fabric.
4. Stitch step 3, which are placement circles for aligning your snaps later.
5. If you would like to add your own decorative design to the handle, stitch that onto the fabric now. You can add your name or other designs to further help make your luggage easy to spot, and differentiate it from other similar-looking bags.
6. Take the hoop off of your machine, but DON'T remove the design from the hoop.
7. Flip the hoop over and use pins to attach a piece of non-fraying fabric on the underside of the hoop, with the right sides of the fabric facing out and wrong sides in the middle.
8. Stitch the last step of the design, which is a finishing stitch that will stitch around the entire design and attach your back piece of fabric.
9. Your design is now finished stitching. Remove the design from the hoop and trim around all 4 sides as desired..
10. Add snaps, centering them on the placement circles, according to the instructions included with your particular snap to complete the handle wrap.
11. Wrap the completed design around the handle of your suitcase or bag and use the snaps to secure it.
