Applique and full stitch 2 sizes digitized files



Full stitch files for hoop 4*4 and 5*7

Hoop 4*4 – 3,96x3,95” (101x100 mm), 7522 stitches

Hoop 5*7 – 4,42x7,02” (112x178 mm), 15126 stitches

4 colors (5 change thread).


Applique design for hoop 5*7 - 4,42x7,02” (112x178 mm), 11254 stitches

DST, EXP, HUS, JEF, PES, XXX, VIP, VP3


How to appliqué a Christmas dachshund

1. Of course, the first thing to do is load your applique design into your embroidery machine.
2. Next hoop the material your finished design will be on. Be sure to stabilize it just as you would for any kind of machine embroidery.
3. Embroidery first 4 thread (black, red, green, black).

You can see the **placement stitch line**. The machine stitches out an outline of where the appliqué fabric should be placed.



4. You should place down your appliqué fabric over the placement stitching. You'll need to hold the fabric in place so it doesn't pucker or bunch up on you. You can try using double-stick tape but usually it's just as easy to hold it down.



5. The **tacking stitch** sews next, tacking the applique fabric down.

After this round of stitching is done, you need to remove the hoop from the machine and trim the appliqué fabric around the tack down stitching line.

Don't unhoop! Get close to the stitches but try not to cut too many of them.



6. Put the hoop back in the machine and push the button.

The final applique stitching will take the longest as the machine is creating a satin stitch all the way around the outside of the appliqué piece.



7. Continue to embroider as usual.



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
