

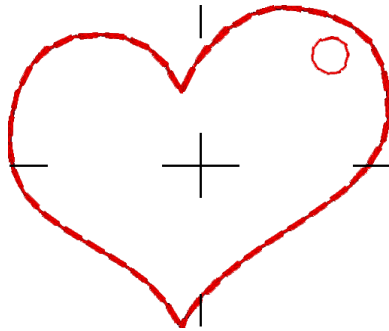

2 " x 1 (11/16)" : 793 Stitches, 3 Colors, 3 Needles

  1: Cinnamon
Sulky Rayon 568
52 stitches, 0.9 yards

  2: Blackberry
Sulky Rayon 1215
99 stitches, 1.1 yards

  3: True Red
Sulky Rayon 1039
642 stitches, 2.3 yards

For this project you will need.

- 2 pieces of vinyl 2.5x2.5
- Embroidery thread and matching bobbin for the final color
- Tape
- Tear away stabilizer
- Grommet and grommet set tool



1. Hoop stabilizer and run the first color for the placement of the heart. Add one piece of the vinyl pretty side up to cover the placement lines.
2. Color two will tack it down. Now you can add any personalization you would like. Once that is done add your final piece of vinyl to the back side of the hoop with the pretty side facing outward. Tape in place. Add your matching bobbin color
3. The final color will stitch the 2 sides of the heart together and add a placement line for the grommet. Once it stitches remove from the hoop, tear away the stabilizer and trim around the heart. Add a grommet where indicated.

Great for a name tag for a gift, a fob, a small banner piece and SO much more





Cheat Sheet Basics

A Hug Longer Digital Design

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Like most things Embroidery takes practice. I have written this cheat sheet to help you determine why your design did not stitch as it should have. Even those of us who have been doing embroidery for a very long time can benefit from these reminders. All Hug Longer designs have been tested prior to release.

My Embroidery file will not fit in the hoop or will not load in my machine

- Have you tried to rotate the file from portrait to landscape or visa versa?
- Verify you have the proper size and format loaded. Is the file unzipped?
- Did you resize the file? Or add to the file?
- Have you tried re downloading the file?

My stitches are not in the correct places

- Is the hoop free moving without obstructions in the way?
- Are you using proper stabilization?
- Is the thread moving freely, have you tried rethreading?
- Does your machine have proper tension for the thread and bobbin?
- Did you properly hoop your item (not too tightly)?
- Is your fabric too dense for the design?
- Does your machine need service?
