COSTUME HEADBAND WITH assembly instructions

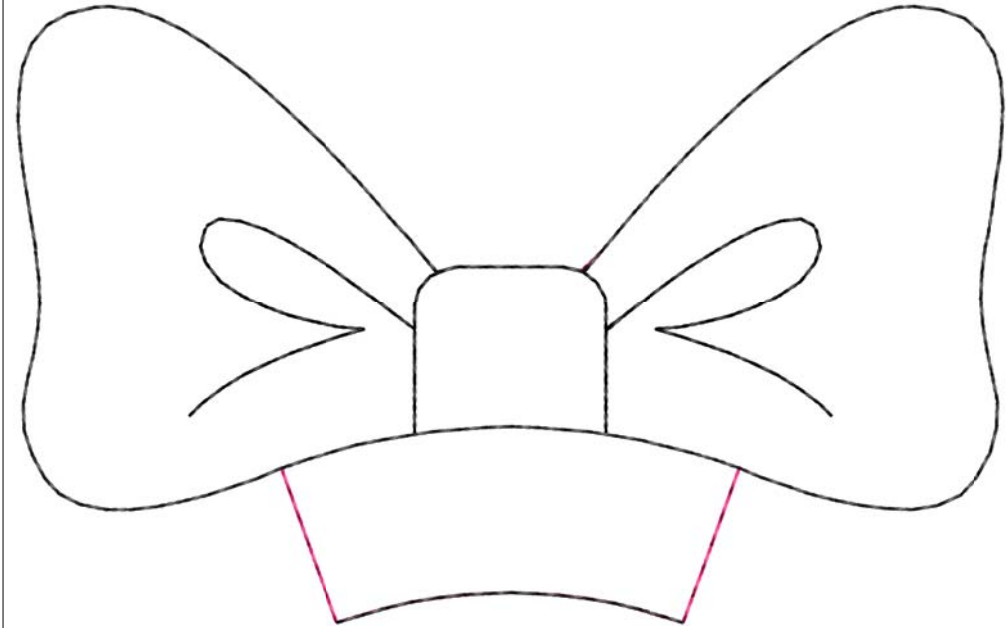
1. Hoop your stabilizer. You can use water soluble stabilizer or tearaway stabilizer.
2. Stitch design step 1 onto the stabilizer. This is your placement stitch and will show you where you need to put your fabric. Use a sturdy non-fraying material, such as felt or vinyl. You will want to use something that is fairly rigid so that the slider will stay upright under its own weight when on the headband. (The finished slider will have 2 layers of fabric.)
3. Place your fabric on top of the placement stitches. (If you like, you can use a little bit of adhesive to keep the fabric in place).
4. Stitch the next step of the design, which will tack down your fabric.
5. Stitch all of the design detail steps (if any). These are the steps that create the cute part of the design. The number of steps will vary depending on your design. For any applique steps included in the cute part of the design, steps 2-4 will be repeated. You can choose any fabric for the decorative applique elements and do not need to use non-fraying material. Trim your applique fabric after each tack down step of the cute part of the design, as closely as possible to the tack down stitches. Stop before stitching the finishing step(s).
6. Once the decorative part of the design is finished, take the hoop off of your machine, but DON'T remove the design from the hoop.
7. [OPTIONAL] If you wish to be able to bend and mold the ears, add some wire to the back side. This will also add rigidity to the design, especially for taller sliders. Flip the hoop over, and using hot glue, on the back attach some small gauge wire about 1/4" inside of the entire outer stitch boundary above the bottom tab before proceeding to the next step.
8. On the back of the hoop, use some adhesive or pins to attach the bottom piece of felt or vinyl on the underside of the hoop. Avoid using adhesive on the bottom tab area, as not to interfere with the opening for the headband.
9. Place your hoop back on the machine and stitch the final outline step(s). This will create an opening for sliding the headband through and stitch around the top portion of the design.
10. Take everything out of the hoop and trim around the outer stitch line.
11. Slide a headband through the opening on the bottom tab, between the two layers. If it feels too loose on the headband, you can use a little hot glue on the headband before sliding the piece into place.
12. If this costume headband has multiple pieces (such as a pair of ears), repeat the instructions above for the other slider piece.

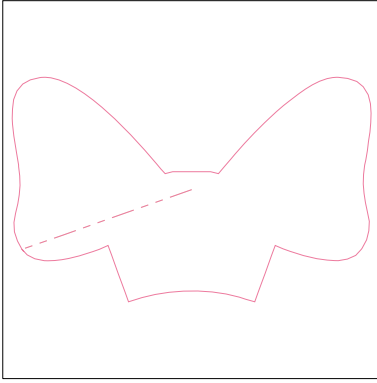
