Step 1-10:Proc 1:Stitch the design following the color chart.

Proc 2:Remove project from hoop and trim, as needed.



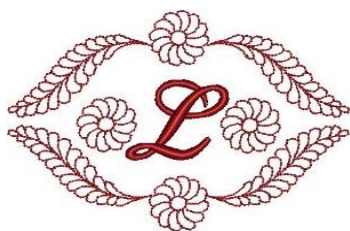

TIP #:	IMPORTANT TIPS:
Tip 1:	For best stitch out results, use Terial Magic to treat your fabric before stitching. I saturate the entire fabric, so there are no missed spots, and then follow the manufacturer's instructions.
Tip 2:	Slow your machine speed down to half (or less) speed. For areas where you are stitching on top of already stitched objects, slow your machine to the lowest or second lowest speed to help prevent thread and needle breaks. Speed is not always your friend in machine embroidery.
Tip 3:	You may want to consider using the same color bobbin thread as the top thread, when using dark colored threads. If any bobbin thread happens to pull up from the bobbin, the stitch out will still look as it should.
Tip 4:	If there are any gaps in the stitching, or pulled up different color bobbin thread, use a PERMANENT FABRIC MARKER to carefully touch up the area in question.
Tip 5:	Use any size hoop, available in your machine brand, that best accomodates the size of the design.

PREP #: PREPARATION:

Prep 1:	Cut fabric at least 2 inches larger than your hoop size. Example: For an 8 x 10 hoop, cut fabric to 10 x 12.
Prep 2:	Hoop fabric and one layer of FNSM stabilizer. Turn the hoop over, WSU, and affix a layer of FTM to the bottom of the hoop, using SET.

PLEASE TREAT FABRIC WITH TERIAL MAGIC BEFORE YOU HOOP!

Greetings!

It is so important to treat your fabric with a stiffener or starch-type product.

You will be so much happier with the results of your stitch out.



For best results, I recommend Terial Magic. It is THE VERY BEST fabric treatment that helps to prevent puckers.




	SA: Seam Allowance

FPT: Floriani Pink Tape	<p>My favorite use of this is putting a length of tape parallel to the presser foot as a seam guide (make sure not to cover the feed dogs).</p> <p>I do not like it for securing fabric or stabilizer on or under the embroidery hoop, as it can come off and if stitched through, it's nearly impossible to remove.</p>	
FNSM: Floriani No Show Mesh stabilizer--comes in giant rolls and varying sizes and colors.	Cut away stabilizer that can be left in the project






