COFFEE CUP COZY ITH

assembly instructions


1. Hoop your stabilizer. You can use water soluble stabilizer or tearaway stabilizer.
2. Stitch design step 1 onto the stabilizer. This is your placement stitch and will show you where you need to put your fabric for the first side.
3. Place your first fabric on top of the placement stitch, with the fabric right side up. (If you like, you can use a little bit of adhesive to keep the fabric in place).
4. If you would like to add your own design to your cup cozy, you can add that now.
5. Place your fabric for the back side on top of the front fabric with the pretty side down. If you also wish to have a layer of batting inside, place that on top of both layers of fabric at the top. You can use pins or tape to keep everything in place.
6. Stitch the last step of the design, which is a finishing step that stitches around the entire design, leaving a hole along the side for turning.
7. Your design is now finished stitching. Remove the design from the hoop and trim around all 4 sides to about $\frac{1}{4}$ inch. You can also cut diagonally at the corners to reduce the bulk.
8. Remove the stabilizer.
9. Turn the cozy right side out through the hole. Iron if needed.
10. If using snaps or velcro, once completed the sleeve will be about 10 inches in circumference at the widest point. For larger cups that require a bigger sleeve, you can use elastic loops and buttons. If using loops and buttons, add the elastic now, before closing the turning hole. Slip the cut ends of the elastic loops into the turning hole and pin in place.
11. You can either hand-sew the turning hole closed, or do a top stitch around the entire design.
12. Add snaps or velcro to the left and right ends, or sew buttons to the opposite end if you used elastic loops.






