GIFT CARD HOLDER ITH assembly instructions

- 1. Hoop your stabilizer. You can use water soluble stabilizer or tearaway stabilizer.
- 2. Stitch design step 1 onto the stabilizer. This is your placement stitch and will show you where you need to put your fabric. Use a sturdy non-fraying material, such as felt or vinyl.
- 3. Place your fabric on top of the placement stitches. (If you like, you can use a little bit of adhesive to keep the fabric in place).
- 4. Stitch the next step of the design, which will tack down your fabric.
- 5. Stitch all of the design detail steps (if any). These are the steps that create the cute part of the design. The number of steps will vary depending on your design. For any applique steps included in the cute part of the design, steps 2-4 will be repeated. Trim your applique fabric after each tack down step of the cute part of the design, as closely as possible to the tack down stitches. Use fabric that won't fray for any applique areas. Stop before stitching the next placement step.
- 6. Trim the top as close as you like, but only trim your fabric to 1/4" around the outside edge on the sides and bottom.
- 7. Stitch the next placement step. This is placement for the fabric for the back of your gift card holder.
- 8. Take the hoop off of your machine, but DON'T remove the design from the hoop.
- 9. On the back of the hoop, use tape or pins to attach the bottom piece of felt or vinyl on the underside of the hoop. Do not use adhesive, as you want the pocket to remain open for your gift card. If your fabric is not pretty on both sides, use 2 pieces of fabric and sandwich them together with the pretty sides facing out.
- 10. Place your hoop back on the machine and stitch the final tack down and outline step(s). This will stitch around the outside of back, leaving the top of the front side open to create a pocket.
- 11. Take everything out of the hoop and trim around the outer stitch line.
- 12. Slide a gift card into the pocket.














