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

# ITH Round Christmas Ornament




## Materials used:

1. Fabric for the top and bottom (according to your taste)
2. Machine embroidery design of the ornament
3. Water soluble stabilizer
4. Embroidery thread
5. Fabric spray adhesive
6. Sticky tape
7. Tape (optional)
8. Curved small scissors
9. Wooden stick (or other similar device).

## Step 1

Take the fabric for the top piece, place it in the hoop and do the outline stitch. Remove the hoop and carefully cut along the outline stitch.



## Step 2

Place the water-soluble stabilizer in the hoop and stitch the outline stitch. Remove the hoop from the machine.

## Step 3

If you want to add a loop of ribbon, fold it in half, place it at the top of the design and secure with tape (sticky tape). Spray the back of the fabric circle with glue.

Place it in the spot marked with the outline stitch.

Place the hoop in the machine and do the securing stitches.

You can use a small wooden stick

(or other suitable tool) to hold the design in place.

Sew the inside of the design.




## Step 4

Remove the hoop from the machine again and place the piece of fabric you will use for the bottom of the piece on the back of the hoop. Secure the fabric with scotch tape. Place the hoop in the machine and sew the locking stitches.

## Step 5

Remove the hoop from the machine and carefully trim the excess fabric around the embroidered design.



## Step 6

Since all of the embroidery from this point on will be visible on both sides, wind the bobbin according to each of the remaining thread colors used in the design.



## Step 7

Place the hoop  
in the machine  
and do the edging stitch.



## Step 8

Remove the stabilizer with the piece from the hoop.  
Cut off the water-soluble stabilizer.

Then remove any residue around the edges  
by gently blotting the edges with a damp cloth.
