

The design on your ornament most likely will be different from the one shown here in the step by step instructions, but all instructions are the same for all ornaments.

Handy dandy color and stitching steps chart is on the last page(s).



Supplies for one ornament:

(2) 5 x 5 inch piece of vinyl (or enough to cover your placement stitches, plus margins)

Stabilizer, a piece big enough for you to completely hoop (cut-away or tear-away)

Embroidery thread, your choice of colors

Your finishing thread should match or compliment your background color, and backing fabric color.

12 inch piece of ribbon

Embroidery needle, size 11 (I use Organ 15X15T)

General supplies:

Scissors, scotch tape, embroidery needles, embroidery machine, sharp object to make hole



- Using your embroidery machine or software, add your lettering or image to the embroidery file.

- Load your file into your machine.

- Hoop the stabilizer and snap onto the machine. Do not put the vinyl on yet. The first stitching will be your placement stitches. You will stitch this right onto the stabilizer. It doesn't really matter what color you use, because you will never see it. This is just so you know where to place your vinyl.



- Place your vinyl on top of your placement stitches. Be sure that you leave at least a quarter inch away from stitching for your margin which you will cut away later. Secure your vinyl (right side should be facing up) to the stabilizer with scotch tape or painters tape.



- Stitch through the various color changes, as well as the personalizing you added, up until the last stitching. These are the details of your design. Before stitching the last color, remove the hoop from the machine. Do not remove the project from the hoop.



- Place your backing fabric over the stitches you see on the underside of the hoop. Again, leave at least a quarter inch margin, and the right side should be facing up. Secure in place with tape.

Remember that at this point, your top thread and your bobbin thread will need to be a color that will either blend in, or compliment your vinyl.



- Stitch your final stitching. Remove from the machine and the hoop. You will notice that you now have an outline stitch all the way around your design which includes your hanger tab. If you used tearaway stabilizer, tear it away. Carefully cut all the way around, keeping your cutting within 1/8 of an inch from the stitches.



- Using a pointed object, poke a hole in the center of the hanger tag. Fold the ribbon in half, using the same object, poke the two raw edges through the hole from the back to the front. Pull it through a few inches. Slip the ribbon ends through the loop (at the fold of the ribbon) and pull until the loop is touching the ornament. Tie a knot to secure the ribbon and trim the excess ends.



If you change the size or density of the original design, you could alter the final result.


