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RASIEL BOY SNOW DOLL



Important! Read through all instructions thoroughly before starting to understand the stitch sequence of this design. Not all steps have a photo so please follow each step carefully. This design is done in 5 hoopings.

Materials Needed – 8x14 inch doll design

Legs	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	9x7 inches	
	Fleece (shoes)	2 pieces	3x6 inches	(This can be any non fray material)
	Fleece (toe)	1 piece	2x5 inches	
Arms	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	7x5 inches	
Body	Fleece /Minky	2 pieces	14x8 inches	
Jacket	Fleece/Minky	2 pieces	7x13 inches	(This can be any non fray material)
	V Insert	Fleece/Minky	1 piece	3x4 inches
	Collar	Fleece /Minky	1 piece	4x6 inches
	Bow	Fleece /Minky	1 piece	2x3 inches
Pants	Fleece/Minky	2 pieces	9x7 inches	
Hat	Fleece/Minky	2 pieces	6x9 inches	

Materials Needed – 7x12 inch doll design

Legs	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	8x6 inches	
	Fleece (shoes)	2 pieces	3x5 inches	(This can be any non fray material)
	Fleece (toe)	1 piece	2x4 inches	
Arms	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	7x5 inches	
Body	Fleece /Minky	2 pieces	12x7 inches	
Jacket	Fleece/Minky	2 pieces	6x11 inches	(This can be any non fray material)
	V Insert	Fleece/Minky	1 piece	3x3 inches
	Collar	Fleece /Minky	1 piece	3x5 inches
	Bow	Fleece /Minky	1 piece	2x2 inches
Pants	Fleece/Minky	2 pieces	8x6 inches	
Hat	Fleece/Minky	2 pieces	5x8 inches	

Materials Needed – 6x10 inch doll design

Legs	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	6x5 inches
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
	Fleece (shoes)	2 pieces	2x4 inches	(This can be any non fray material)
	Fleece (toe)	1 piece	2x4 inches	
Arms	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	5x4 inches	
Body	Fleece /Minky	2 pieces	10x6 inches	
Jacket	Fleece/Minky	2 pieces	5x9 inches	(This can be any non fray material)
V Insert	Fleece/Minky	1 piece	2x3 inches	
Collar	Fleece /Minky	1 piece	3x4 inches	
Bow	Fleece /Minky	1 piece	1x2 inches	
Pants	Fleece/Minky	2 pieces	6x5 inches	
Hat	Fleece/Minky	2 pieces	5x7 inches	

Materials Needed – 5x7 inch doll design

Legs	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	5x4 inches	
	Fleece (shoes)	2 pieces	2x3 inches	(This can be any non fray material)
	Fleece (toe)	1 piece	1x2 inches	
Arms	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	3x4 inches	
Body	Fleece /Minky	2 pieces	7x5 inches	
Jacket	Fleece/Minky	2 pieces	4x7 inches	(This can be any non fray material)
V Insert	Fleece/Minky	1 piece	2x2 inches	
Collar	Fleece /Minky	1 piece	2x3 inches	
Bow	Fleece /Minky	1 piece	1x2 inches	
Pants	Fleece/Minky	2 pieces	4x4 inches	
Hat	Fleece/Minky	2 pieces	3x5 inches	

1. Legs and shoes

Step 1 - Place tear- away stabilizer into the hoop. Stitch the placement stitch.



Step 2 - Place fabric right side up. Stitch outline. Stitch outline of shoe. Place fabric for shoes (Fleece or any soft stretch non fray fabric) on the feet. Run the tack down stitch. Remove from machine cut away excess material from top and bottom. Return to machine to run placement stitch for the toe.



Step 3 - Place fabric right side up for toe, run the tack down stitch for toe. Remove from machine to trim the top of toe. Return to machine and run the embroidery details.



Step 4 – Place same fabric as for shoe face down over shoe. Stitch the outline. This will be the back of the shoe.



Step 5 –Place same material used for leg face down over leg and shoe and stitch outline, final stitching.




Step 6 – Remove from the hoop. Tear away all stabilizer. Cut additional fabric away and around corners to assist with round edges and turn out. Keep for when body is stitched, to add to body on indicated placement stitches.




2. Arms

Step 1 - Place tear-away stabilizer into the hoop. Stitch the placement stitch. Place fabric right side up. Stitch outline.



Step 2 – Place another piece of fabric right side together over the fabric and stitch final stitch.



Step 3 – Remove from the hoop. Tear away all stabilizer. Cut additional fabric away and around corners to assist with round edges and turn out. Keep for assembly later with ladder stitch to body.



3. Body

Step 1 -Place tear- away stabilizer into the hoop. Run placement stitch. Place fabric for body right side up hold in place with tape or pins. Run the tack down stitch for body.



Step 2 – Place water soluble topping over head area. Run the detail stitching on the head.



Step 3 –Remove the water soluble topping.

Step 4 - Stitch the 2 placement stitches to show where to place the legs. Place legs (turned outside) on body where the top of the leg is in the direction of the bottom of the body. Stitch the 2 stay stitches to keep the legs in place. Then fold feet under legs and tape down to keep them out of the way of the final stitch outline of body.



Step 5– Place same material used for the body face down over legs and body and stitch outline.




Step 6 - Remove from the hoop. Tear away all stabilizer. Cut additional fabric away and around corners to assist with round edges and clip in neck edge carefully and turn out.



4. JACKET

Step 1 - Place tear-away stabilizer into the hoop. Run placement stitch



Step 2 - Place non fray fabrics like fleece face up for the front. Run tack down stitch. Run placement stitch for V insert. Place fabric over the placement stitch, run the tack down stitch. Remove from machine, do not unhoop, trim the V.



Step 3 - Return to machine run the placement stitch for the collar. Remove the hoop from machine, do not unhoop. Place fabric over collar and return to machine to tack down. Trim collar.



Step 4 –Run the embroidery details and placement line for bow. Place the material for bow over the placement line, run the tack down stitch.Remove from machine, do not unhoop, trim the bow.



Step 5 – Return to machine run the embroidery details for the bow.



Step 6 – Place back fabric over jacket right sides together and run final stitches.



Step 7 –Remove from hoop, remove all tear away and trim edges then turn the jacket out.



5. PANTS

Step 1 - Place tear-away stabilizer into the hoop. Run placement stitch



Step 2 - Place non fray fabrics like fleece face up for the top front. Run tack down stitch. Run the embroidery details.



Step 3 – Place back fabric over pants right sides together and run final stitches.



Step 4 –Remove from hoop, remove all tear away and trim edges then turn the pants out.



6. Hat

This hat can be made using just felt or felt and fabric. I will give instructions for both.

Step 1 - Place tear-away stabilizer into the hoop. Stitch the placement stitch. Place a piece of felt for the hat over the placement line, run the tack down stitch. If using fabric place this on top of your felt before you run the tack down stitch.



Step 2 – Run the embroidery details.



Step 3 –Remove hoop from machine, do not un hoop. Turn the hoop over and place a piece of felt over the area, tape down well to hold in place. For the fabric hat no felt on the back but place the fabric face down right sides together on the front. Run the tack down stitch or final stitch.



Step 4 - Remove from the hoop. Tear away all stabilizer. Cut additional fabric away leaving the back as long as the placement stitch but the front cut close to embroidered stitching. For the fabric hat fold the front to the back.



6. Assembling body

Step 1 – Cut around body to ensure that corners turn out complete. Turn inside out. Fill the legs and close the side of the leg with ladder stitch



Step 2 – Fill the body and head and close side opening with ladder stitch.

Step 3 – Fill the arms and close with ladder stitch. Then sew the arms to the body.



Step 4 – Place clothing on from the bottom upwards.

Project complete
