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EZRA FAWN BOY DOLL



Important! Read through all instructions thoroughly before starting to understand the stitch sequence of this design. Not all steps have a photo so please follow each step carefully. This design is done in 7 hoopings.

Materials Needed – 8x14 inch doll design

Legs	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	9X7 inches	
	Fleece (shoes)	2 pieces	3x6 inches	(This can be any non fray material)
Arms	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	7X5 inches	
Ears	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	4X5 inches	
Horns	Felt/ stabilizer	3 pieces	5x6 inches	
Body	Fleece /Minky	2 pieces	8x14 inches	
Head	Fleece /Minky	1 pieces	6x8 inches	
Shirt	Fleece	2 pieces	7x8 inches	(This can be any non fray material)
Vest	Fleece	1 pieces	7X7 inches	
Collar	Fleece	1 piece	3x5 inches	
Pants	Fleece	2 piece	9x8 inches	(This can be any non fray material)

Materials Needed – 7x12 inch doll design

Legs	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	7X6 inches	
	Fleece (shoes)	2 pieces	3X6 inches	(This can be any non fray material)
Arms	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	7X5 inches	
Ears	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	3X5 inches	
Horns	Felt/ stabilizer	3 pieces	4X5 inches	
Body	Fleece /Minky	2 pieces	10X6 inches	
Head	Fleece /Minky	1 pieces	5X6 inches	
Shirt	Fleece	2 pieces	6X6 inches	(This can be any non fray material)
Vest	Fleece	1 pieces	6X6 inches	
Collar	Fleece	1 piece	3X5 inches	
Pants	Fleece	2 piece	8X7 inches	(This can be any non fray material)

Materials Needed – 6x10 inch doll design


Legs	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	6X5 inches	
	Fleece (shoes)	2 pieces	2X4 inches	(This can be any non fray material)
Arms	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	5X4 inches	
Ears	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	3X4 inches	
Horns	Felt/ stabilizer	3 pieces	4X4 inches	
Body	Fleece /Minky	2 pieces	10X6 inches	
Head	Fleece /Minky	1 pieces	6X6 inches	
Shirt	Fleece	2 pieces	5X6 inches	(This can be any non fray material)
Vest	Fleece	1 pieces	5X6 inches	
Collar	Fleece	1 piece	2X4 inches	
Pants	Fleece	2 piece	6X6 inches	(This can be any non fray material)

Materials Needed – 5x7 inch doll design

Legs	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	5X4 inches	
	Fleece (shoes)	2 pieces	2X4 inches	(This can be any non fray material)
Arms	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	4X3 inches	
Ears	Fleece/minky	2 pieces	3X4 inches	
Horns	Felt/ stabilizer	3 pieces	3X4 inches	
Body	Fleece /Minky	2 pieces	7X5 inches	
Head	Fleece /Minky	1 pieces	4X4 inches	
Shirt	Fleece	2 pieces	4X4 inches	(This can be any non fray material)
Vest	Fleece	1 pieces	4X4 inches	
Collar	Fleece	1 piece	2X4 inches	
Pants	Fleece	2 piece	5X4 inches	(This can be any non fray material)

1. Legs and shoes

Step 1 - Place tear- away stabilizer into the hoop. Stitch the placement stitch.




Step 2 - Place fabric right side up. Stitch outline. Stitch outline of shoe. Place fabric for shoes (Fleece or any soft stretch non fray fabric) on the feet. When complete cut away excess material from top.



Step 3 -Stitch the details on shoe.



Step 4 – Place same fabric as for shoe face down over shoe. Stitch the outline. This will be the back of the shoe.



Step 5 –Place same material used for leg face down over leg and shoe and stitch outline, final stitching.



Step 6 – Remove from the hoop. Tear away all stabilizer. Cut additional fabric away and around corners to assist with round edges and turn out. Keep for when body is stitched to add to body on indicated placement stitches.



2. Arms

Step 1 - Place tear-away stabilizer into the hoop. Stitch the placement stitch. Place fabric right side up. Stitch outline.



Step 2 – Place another piece of fabric right side together over the fabric and stitch final stitch.



Step 3 – Remove from the hoop. Tear away all stabilizer. Cut additional fabric away and around corners to assist with round edges and turn out. Keep for assembly later with ladder stitch to body.



3. Horns

Step 1 - Place tear-away stabilizer into the hoop. Run placement stitch.(I changed the bobbin to have the same color thread)



Step 2 – Place stabilizer(I used a bag stiffener), then felt over placement line, turn hoop over and place a piece of felt over the placement line on the back, secure well with tape, stitch the tack down stitch.



Step 3 – Run the decorative stitch. Run alignment stitches for when placing on the head.




Step 4 – Remove from hoop, tear away the stabilizer, trim close to stitching. This to be kept for later when body is stitched out.



4. Ears

Step 1 - Place tear-away stabilizer into the hoop. Stitch the placement stitch. Place a piece of fabric facing upwards that will represent the inner ear on the stabilizer.



Step 2 –Run the tack down stitch of the inner ear and run alignment stitches for when placing on the head. Run the fold line stitch.



Step 3- Place a piece of material that is same as body, face down over the ear.

Stitch final stitching to complete.



Step 4 - Remove from the hoop. Tear away all stabilizer. Cut additional fabric away and around corners to assist with round edges and turn out. This to be kept for later when body is stitched out. Fold the ear along the placement line, tape or pin to keep in place.



5. Body

Step 1 - Place tear-away stabilizer into the hoop. Run placement stitch. Place fabric for body right side up hold in place with tape. Stitch outline. Run placement stitch for the top of head.



Step 2 – Place fabric over placement line, stitch the tack down stitch.



Step 3 – Remove from machine, do not un hoop, trim close to stitching inside the head only.



Step 4 – Place water soluble topping over head area. Run the detail stitching on the head.



Step 5 - Remove the water soluble topping. Run the placement stitches for the horns. Place horns face down, line up the alignment stitches. Run the tack down stitches.



Step 6 - Stitch the 2 placement stitches to show where ears must go. Place ears on head face down. Stitch the 2 stay stitches to keep the ears in place.



Step 7 – Stitch the 2 placement stitches to show where to place the legs. Place legs (turned outside) on body where the top of the leg is in the direction of the bottom of the body. Stitch the 2 stay stitches to keep the legs in place. Then fold feet under legs and tape down to keep them out of the way of the final stitch outline of body.



Step 8 – Place same material used for the body face down over legs and body and stitch outline.



Step 9 - Remove from the hoop. Tear away all stabilizer. Cut additional fabric away and around corners to assist with round edges and turn out.



6. Shirt

Step 1 - Place tear-away stabilizer into the hoop. Run placement stitch.



Step 2 - Place non fray fabrics like fleece face up for the front. Run placement stitch for shirt. Run the placement stitch for the vest. Place fabric over vest and run tack down stitch.



Step 3 – Remove the hoop from machine, do not un hoop, trim fabric around vest and neckline on shirt as shown.



Step 4 - Run the placement stitch for the collar. Remove the hoop from machine, do not un hoop, place fabric over the placement stitch for collar. Return hoop to machine run the tack

down stitch. Remove the hoop from machine, do not un hoop, trim collar close to stitching. Return hoop to machine run the embroidery details.



Step 5 – Place back fabric over shirt right sides together. Return hoop to machine. Run the final stitches.




Step 6 –Remove from hoop, remove all tear away and trim edges then turn the shirt out.



7. Pants

Step 1 – Load pattern and hoop tear away stabilizer. Run placement line. Place fabric right side up over placement line and tack down. Run stitching details on pants.



Step 2 – Place the back fabric over pants, tape in place, stitch final stitching.



Step 3 – Remove hoop from machine, remove from hoop, trim close to all edges. Remove all tear away. Turn the pants out.



8. Assembling body

Step 1 – Cut around body to ensure that corners turn out complete. Turn inside out. Fill the legs and close the side of the leg with ladder stitch



Step 2 – Fill the body and head and close side opening with ladder stitch.

Step 3 – Fill the arms and close with ladder stitch. Then sew the arms to the body.



Step 4 – Place shirt and pants on from the bottom upwards.

Project complete
